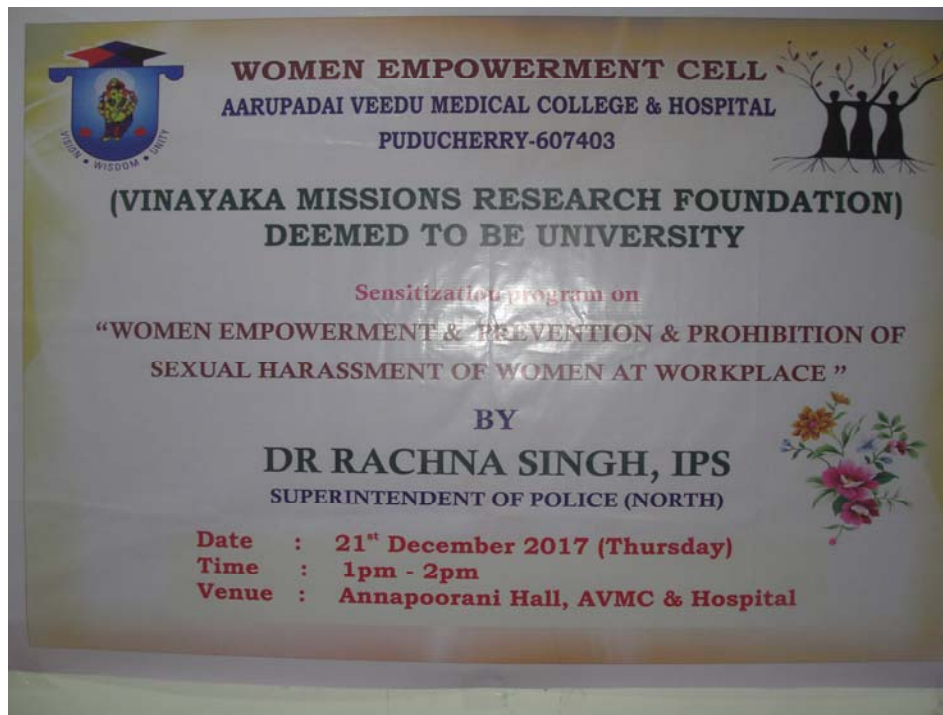
Dr. Rachna Singh IPS, Superintendent of Police (North), Puducherry is a well known personality in Puducherry.
